The Need

When receiving leave to remain, refugees commonly become homeless.

With demand high, it can be difficult for single people to prove they have a priority need for accommodation.

Yet many single refugees suffer from mental and physical health conditions making them more vulnerable. This may mean councils have a duty to house them.

The Training

- when and how to challenge homelessness decisions
