Cancer Research UK want to find out what information from their website will be most useful to users with accessibility needs and lower literacy levels, and what is the best way to access this information.



CHANGE will be holding a focus group in June to collect peoples' views. We are inviting people that have accessibility needs and lower literacy levels when viewing information to the focus group.



We are looking for people with learning disabilities and people from communities where additional access to information is needed.



These communities include but are not limited to people from the Deaf community, migrant community, Gypsy and traveller community, and people with lower literacy levels that have been through the criminal justice system.



We are also looking for people with learning disabilities and people from communities where additional access to information is needed, who have had cancer or cared for someone with cancer.



Part of the focus group will be filmed. This will help Cancer Research UK collect reactions to their information.



You do not have to be filmed if you do not want to be. You can still attend the focus group. Those who are filmed will need to sign a consent form.




The focus group will be accessible to everyone who attends.


