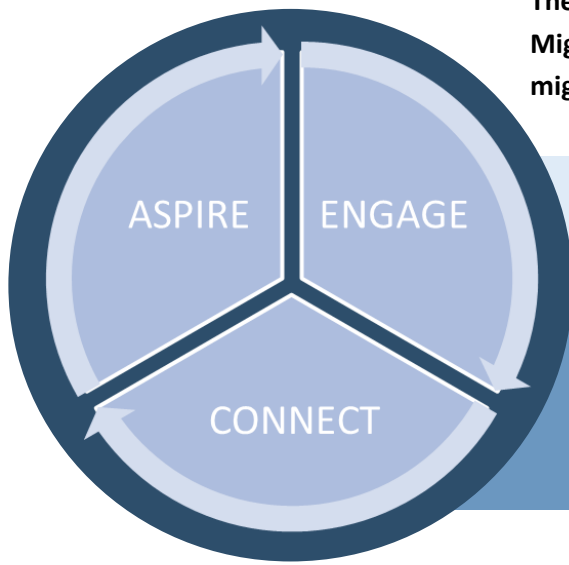


The New Roots project is part funded by the EU Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund. Making management of migration flows more efficient across the European Union.

NEW ROOTS is a service run in collaboration between RETAS, Refugee Council and PATH Yorkshire that has been designed to provide a holistic approach to supporting Refugees across Leeds and West Yorkshire. The Integration model will support refugees in 3 stages, with flexible entry points:

ENGAGE: Move on and crisis support.

CONNECT: Social integration and wellbeing activities.

ASPIRE: Education, Training and Employment.

This model is delivered between the three partner organisations who join together at a weekly drop-in, whilst providing individual services through their established roots in the community.
