**Museums:** Leeds City Museum – Leeds City Museum, Millennium Square, Leeds LS2 8BH, The Royal Armouries – Armouries Drive, Leeds LS10 1LT

**Walks:**

- \* Cow & Calf Rocks – Cow & Calf Rocks, Ilkley Moor, LS29 9RF,
- \* The Lines Way – trail of the old railway track (passes 4 nature reserves – Letchmire Pastures, Townclose Hills, Hollinghurst Wood & Owl Wood and Pit Plantation) – The Lines Way, Leeds, WF10 2AF,
- \* Meanwood Valley Trail – starts near the junction between Woodhouse Lane and Raglan Road, Leeds LS2 9DZ,
- \* Chevin Forest Park – lots of trails & footpaths – Chevin Forest Park, East Chevin Road, Otley, Leeds LS21 3HB

**Activities:**

- \*The Tetley – bookmaking, robot designs, printing & more – The Tetley, Hunslet Road, Leeds LS10 1JQ,
- \* Owl Trail – search for the 25 hidden owls in Leeds. Pick up a map from the Art Gallery in Leeds City Centre – starts at: Millennium Square, Leeds LS2 8BH
- \* Nature Reserves: Rodley Nature Reserve – full list online

**Parks:**

- \* Roundhay Park – tennis courts, skate park or walk round the lake & have a picnic – Roundhay Park, Princes Avenue, Roundhay, Leeds LS8 1DF, Golden Acre Park – 55 acres to cover – Golden Acre Park, Arthington Road, Bramhope, Leeds LS16 8BQ
- \* Leeds Urban Bike Park – tracks to ride around – Middleton Park, Bike Hub Ring Road, Beeston Park, Leeds LS10 3TN
- \* Woodhouse Moor Skatepark – Woodhouse Lane, Leeds LS2 3AP

**Heritage:**

- \* Kirkstall Abbey – roam around the ruins, 1 kilometre trail – Kirkstall Abbey, Abbey Road, Leeds LS5 3EH
