WEEK FOUR

Build confidence at interview. Find out what is expected and get a chance to practice

The time commitment:

A 2 hour class each week for 4 weeks **plus** time for work at home. You **must** commit to attending all 4 sessions.

Travel expenses:

Bus and train tickets for travel to and from the course will be reimbursed for those on the programme.

Participants will receive a certificate on completion of the course and the chance to:

- Go on employer, education and volunteering **group visits**
- Undertake a **supported work placement** to build work confidence and get a reference for future job applications
- Receive extra employability support through a **weekly drop in**

Individuals must meet **eligibility criteria** to participate: refugee status, family reunion, humanitarian protection or discretionary leave to remain as a result of asylum.
