Ensure representatives attend Leeds Domestic Violence Forum	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PAFRAS attended 2 DV meetings – happy to represent LMP at the Forum • PAFRAS invited to attend working with male perpetrators • Got clarification on timescales and responsibilities when applying for DDV concession. • Linked PAFRAS in more closely with IDVAs.
Seek greater clarity on availability/access to use of Refuge Spaces	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Beacon have a bed available for men and women victims of DV for 2 nights for clients who are NRPF in "desperate situation". • Gap applying for DDV concession could be up to 2 weeks – nothing in place to cover accommodation for women during this time. Encouraged to complain to Home Office if a long wait is experienced
Promoting Leeds Domestic Violence Service Quality Mark to members via Blog and meetings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leeds Refugee Forum (LRF) have completed training for more than 20 RCOs members. LRF's staff have a training session booked on the Quality Mark. • PAFRAS working towards DV quality mark currently – encourage all organisations to do this
