## **Q&A** sessions for participants and Keyworkers

Connecting Opportunities is holding an online Q&A session focusing on youth training opportunities. We have speakers from the following organisations who are currently delivering employment training for people up to the age of 30 years.

The session is open to both workers and participants and will be held on Wednesday 11th August from 1 – 3 pm. Our speakers will be able to give you more details about their offer, answer questions and accept referrals.

Career Foundations Traineeship	Career Foundations offer an 8-week programme including a 2-week work placement for young people aged 19-24 in a variety of industries, <b>from business admin to construction</b> . Programmes are available across Yorkshire & Humber.
Springboard Sector Based Work Academy	Springboard is a charity helping people find work in the <b>hospitality, leisure, and tourism industries.</b> This scheme is open to young people up to the age of 30 years and offers a 3-5-week course, industry recognised qualifications and support into work. The scheme operates across Yorkshire & Humber.
We Care Academy Kickstart Scheme	The 'We Care Academy' are working with different organisations in Leeds across Adult Social Care to create 6 month paid placement opportunities to young people aged 19-24.
Generation UK Training programmes	Generation UK run 3-6-week programmes open to young people aged 18-29 and looking to launch a career in <b>customer service, software engineering or healthcare.</b> The training scheme provides mentorship support and actively matchmake learners to interview for roles with employers in the respective sectors. Open to young people living in West Yorkshire.
