## What is the Project?

Leeds Museums and Galleries will celebrate the International Week of Refugees (20-25th of June 2023) and International Refugee Day (20th June 2023).

A creative programme has been launched to do this: We are looking to cover the giant map at Leeds City Museum with handmade Sunflowers which will be on display from 20th – 25th June 2023. We are looking for volunteers to assist visits to groups around the city; run craft activities on site and support the installation of the project on the 19th June 2023.

Use your own interests and skills, through community engagement with groups across Leeds

Become part of a friendly team and assist with craft activities and the coordination of events

Develop your social and communication skills

Meet people from all walks of life and make new friends

Learn how to handle objects

Talk with people from a variety of backgrounds, faiths and cultures

Assist with craft activities

Encourage families and visitors to take part in the sunflower competition

Share information on the journey of refugees or people who have sought asylum

Share news of the free access offer to our sites for refugees and those seeking asylum

Attend relevant training and induction

The role will suit you if you are friendly, enthusiastic and reliable. Ideally you will enjoy working as a team and be keen to learn and gain experience.

Volunteers should be willing to abide by the Council's code of conduct.
