#### Research into anti-social behaviour

Migration Yorkshire is collaborating with their partners at Leeds Beckett University (LBU) to carry out a small-scale research project on the experiences of antisocial behaviour of refugees and recently settled populations, an issue currently not explored in academic or practice debate. ### STEP Ukraine - new classes

STEP Ukraine are pleased to announce that they have new start dates available in September and November 2024 for their free, 12-week intensive programme offering English language and employment support to Ukrainians in the UK. So far, STEP Ukraine has supported almost 10,000 Ukrainians living in the UK to learn English and find meaningful employment.

#### **Eligibility**

All applicants must be Ukrainian, over 18 and living in the UK on the HfU,
 Family Visa or Visa Extension schemes.

#### A reminder of what STEP Ukraine involves:

- An intensive 10 weeks of 2.5 hour daily English classes by the British Council, with options to take the lessons morning, afternoon, or evening.
- 12 weeks of weekly employment support with a dedicated employment advisor, to support with: CV writing, job applications, interview prep, support with job search, and specialist workshops.
- All classes are remote, teacher led and free to attend. They are streamed so all classmates are at a similar level.

### **Housing cover at the Reginald Centre**

From 1st August Housing Advisers will no longer be present at the Reginald Centre to support people with housing advice and queries. Guests and hosts are still encouraged to visit where HfU team staff will be able to help with most general queries. We may have to direct people to Housing Options at Merrion House if they wish to register a new housing application and get more detailed advice. This is due to a reduction in demand for the service. We will keep these changes under review and will send further updates as necessary. It is important that every guest has completes housing application and assessment as soon as possible after they arrive in Leeds so that we can assess their long term housing needs.

### **Case study - Marvellous and Liudmyla's story**

Marvellous and Liudmyla both needed new places to live. Thanks to the generosity of host Steve, both were able to live separately in his Leeds city centre apartment.

Marvellous and her son Braian were Ukrainian nationals who came to Leeds in 2022 and needed a new host almost as soon as they arrived. The Homes for Ukraine (HfU) team supported them to find alternative accommodation. Two possible hosts were found, but both declined owing to Marvellous's background.

The third rematch was a success with new host Steve who offered a self-contained Leeds city centre apartment. Marvellous was able to find work in the NHS and Braian is doing well at school.

In January 2024, Marvellous and Braian were rehoused into a two bed Council property. Working with Housing Leeds, the HfU team ensured they settled into their new home.

Marvellous said, "Where I was initially experiencing racism, I have finally found my home and stability for my child. The HfU team and Steve made this possible, thank you."

Steve's apartment has now been given to another Ukrainian family who were threatened with homelessness, Liudmyla and her daughter Kateryna, after their previous home was needed back for their host's family.

Due to Steve living in Edinburgh, the HfU team arranged the transition between the two families, taking the keys, videoing the flat's condition and helping Liudmyla to move in. We're grateful to Steve for trusting us to sort this out.

"We'd been asked to move and were struggling to find anywhere suitable. Thanks very much to Steve and the HfU team for helping us to move into our new home," said Liudmyla.
